Call to Action: Stop the U.S.- Israeli Genocide in Palestine

Internationalist greetings! Welcome to a new edition of the **In Movement** Newsletter, brought to you by the **International Peoples' Assembly (IPA)**. As we approach Palestine Land Day on March 30, 2025, we call for worldwide mobilization to stand in solidarity with the Palestinian people and demand an immediate end to the brutal Zionist aggression on Palestine. Land Day is an annual day of action which began on March 30, 1976, remembering the Palestinian people's resistance to land theft and occupation. This year, as the situation in Palestine is critical, it is more urgent than ever that we raise our voices and show our collective strength for a Free Palestine.



Weeks after the conclusion of the first phase of the ceasefire agreement in Gaza, the Zionist war machine has resumed its brutal attacks on the people of Gaza, intensifying its targeting of civilians with aerial bombings. This renewed

aggression has resulted in already more than 400 martyrs—including women, children, and the elderly—while thousands have been forced to flee once again, exacerbating an already catastrophic humanitarian crisis that worsens by the day.

It has become evident that the first phase of the ceasefire was nothing more than a maneuver by the occupation, as it refused to implement many agreed-upon commitments. The border crossings largely remained closed, preventing the entry of much-needed humanitarian aid for Gaza's population. Moreover, other key provisions of the agreement were disregarded, such as the partial release of Palestinian prisoners from Israeli jails. Meanwhile, the occupation continued to target various areas of Gaza while escalating its aggression in the West Bank, leading to more casualties and destruction. This ongoing violence reflects the continuation of Israel's policies of oppression, starvation, and siege against the Palestinian people.

This renewed aggression highlights the ongoing Israeli policies of oppression, violence, and siege that have plagued the Palestinian people for decades. From the targeting of civilians in Gaza to the continued settlement expansion in the West Bank, Israel's actions represent a blatant disregard for international law and human rights. The U.S., as a key ally and enabler of Israeli aggression, must be held accountable for its role in escalating the situation.

In that regard, **we call for a mobilization from March 18 to 30** to reject the escalation of Zionist aggression on the people of Gaza and to stand in solidarity with the Palestinian people. This is a crucial moment to intensify international solidarity efforts and to remind the world that the Palestinian struggle is a struggle for all of humanity.

On March 30, Land Day, we urge all solidarity organizations, social movements, and activists to take to the streets in massive mobilizations, raise awareness, and amplify the Palestinian cause. Whether you're organizing a protest, posting on social media, or sharing videos, photos, and messages, every action counts.

We stand with the Palestinian people in their fight for self-determination, sovereignty, and justice!

IV International Dilemmas of Humanity Conference

For a Peaceful and Sovereign Syria

The IPA condemns the sectarian massacres in Syria's coastal region in the beginning of March, which have claimed the lives of more than 1,300 people—including entire families, women, and children. This devastating violence highlights the urgent need for a unified, sovereign, and democratic Syria, free from foreign interference and occupation. The ongoing crisis in Syria is fueled by imperialist forces, with Turkey, the U.S., and Israel contributing to instability. The IPA rejects partition and domination projects, including Zionist plans to destabilize the region. Free Mahmoud Khalil, Free Palestine

Join us in demanding the release of Mahmoud Khalil, a Palestinian student activist and recent Columbia University graduate in the U.S., who was abducted from his home by Department of Homeland Security agents on March 8 and is now being held in detention. Mahmoud is the first known target of the Trump administration's newly established Anti-Semitism Task Force, which seeks to criminalize and deport students in the U.S. for engaging in constitutionally protected speech in support of Palestine. A series of mobilizations and initiatives for Khalil's freedom have been taking place in the United States and around the world in recent weeks. U.S. Out of Korea

The IPA, the International League of Peoples' Struggle (ILPS), and the Nodutdol for Korean Community Development released a statement demanding the cancellation of Freedom Shield 25—a massive joint military exercise involving the U.S., South Korea, and other allied forces, rehearsing war scenarios against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. These drills escalate tensions, violate Korea's sovereignty, and increase the risk of military
